





Traffic patterns will change on the north side of W. Broadway at Maple and Cypress streets

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Arbutus Station. With the anticipated arrival of both tunnel boring machines (TBMs) this spring, there will be temporary traffic pattern changes on the north side of W. Broadway to accommodate the TBM disassembly and removal at Cypress Street.


Timing

These temporary traffic pattern changes will be in place through the summer.

What to expect

- Cypress Street north of W. Broadway will be closed to vehicle and cyclists.
- Maple Street north of W. Broadway will be reopened to vehicles and cyclists to facilitate north-south access to the neighbourhood and businesses on the north side of W. Broadway.
- The Broadway crosswalk on the west side of Cypress Street will be temporarily closed. The east-side crosswalk will remain open.
- Temporary lane closures and turn restrictions on W. Broadway.
- Pedestrians and cyclists will be detoured around the work.

Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
