

Line painting overnight on May 13 & 14 along Broadway

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the Millennium Line extension. Maintaining clear traffic lines are important to keep motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians safe. While there will continue to be temporary changes to accommodate some activities, the current traffic configuration along Broadway will remain in place until the traffic decks are removed later in the project. Traffic paint lines on portions of Broadway and Cambie Street will be refreshed overnight on May 13 and 14.

Timing

- Line painting will take place overnight on May 13 and 14 from 7 p.m. until 3 a.m. the following morning.

What to expect

- Overnight work
- Intermittent elevated noise related to refreshing of road markings.
- Temporary traffic changes will be implemented on Broadway in proximity to all future station construction sites, as well as Cambie Street between W. 7th and W. 12th avenues.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, installing white noise back-up signals on some equipment, monitoring any noisy activities so that mitigation measures can be adapted as needed, and directing lights away from residential buildings.
