





Concrete Activity between March 11 and April 11, 2025 at Oak-VGH Station

March 10, 2025

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation has made significant progress throughout February, pouring more than 1,500 cubic meters of concrete at the future Oak-VGH Station. That's enough concrete to fill more than half of an Olympic-sized swimming pool. Multiple upcoming concrete pours have been scheduled for March as we continue to build the walls, columns, and floors of the station. Further details are available below.



Construction Activities

Multiple concrete pours will take place:

- On Friday, March 21, 2025; work hours are from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m., with the first concrete truck arriving on-site around 7 a.m. 60 trucks are expected for this pour.
- Daily from Tuesday, March 11 to Friday, April 11; work hours are Monday to Friday from 6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., with the first concrete trucks arriving on-site around 7 a.m. Up to 10 trucks per day are expected for these pours.



What to expect

- Concrete pumps will be located inside the station site, east of Oak St. on W. Broadway, and in the emergency laneway on Laurel Street. Concrete trucks will utilize the laneway south of W. Broadway, between Laurel St. and Oak St., for truck access to the site.
- Low-noise work will continue into the evening to complete related activities.
- Please note that concrete trucks are required to have their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning, and to use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.



Traffic

Temporary traffic changes may be in place during the concrete pour as follows:

- Existing parking restrictions in the southbound parking lane on Laurel St., Monday to Friday from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m., will be extended until Friday, April 11.
- Traffic control personnel will be on-site to manage pedestrians, cyclists and concrete trucks.
- Access to businesses, health services, and residences will be maintained for all activities.
