

Concrete pours April 1 and 3 at future Broadway-City Hall Station

March 31, 2025

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation has scheduled concrete pours at the future Broadway-City Hall Station on April 1 and 3. Further details are below.



Construction Activities

Concrete pours will take place on April 1 and 3

- **April 1:** Work hours are from 6:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The first concrete truck will arrive at around 8 a.m.
- **April 3:** Work hours are from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. The first concrete truck will arrive at around 7 a.m.
- Low-noise work will continue into the evening on both nights to complete related activities.



What to expect

- A concrete pump truck will be located inside the construction site laydown area on both April 1 and April 3. There will also be a concrete pump truck set up on Yukon Street south of W. Broadway on April 3.
- Approximately 9 concrete trucks are anticipated on April 1, while 95 concrete trucks are anticipated on April 3.
- Please note that concrete trucks are required to have their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning, and to use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.



Traffic

Temporary traffic changes may be in place during the concrete pour as follows:

- Concrete trucks will arrive to and leave from the construction site via Yukon Street between Broadway and W. 12th Avenue.
