



Concrete pours March 11, 13 and 15 at future Broadway-City Hall Station

March 10, 2025

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation has scheduled concrete pours at the future Broadway-City Hall Station on March 11, 13 and 15. Further details are below.



Construction Activities

Concrete pours will take place on:

- March 11, 13 and 15. Work hours are from 7 a.m. to 4p.m. The first concrete truck will arrive on site around 8 a.m.
- Low-noise work will continue into the evening to complete related activities.



What to expect

- Please note that concrete trucks are required to have their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning, and to use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.
- The concrete pump will be located inside the construction site laydown area.
- Between 35 and 45 concrete trucks are anticipated on March 11 and 13; Approximately 15 concrete trucks are anticipated on March 15



Traffic

Temporary traffic changes may be in place during the concrete pour as follows:

- Concrete trucks will arrive to and leave from the construction site via Yukon Street between Broadway and W. 12th Avenue.
