





Concrete pours March 25, 27 and 28 at the future Mount Pleasant Station

March 24, 2025

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation has scheduled concrete pours at the future Mount Pleasant Station on March 25, 27 and 28. Further details are below.



Construction Activities

Concrete pours will take place on March 25, 27 and 28. Work hours:

- March 25 8 a.m. to 3 p.m., with the first concrete truck arriving on site around 9 a.m.
- March 27 6 a.m. to 3 p.m., with the first concrete truck arriving on site around 7 a.m.
- March 28 8 a.m. to 1 p.m., with the first concrete truck arriving on site around 9 a.m.



What to expect

- A concrete pump truck will be set up on Quebec Street south of E. Broadway for each of these pours. On March 27, a second concrete pump truck will be set up inside the construction site laydown.
- Two concrete trucks are anticipated on March 25; 15 concrete trucks on March 27; and one concrete truck on March 28.
- Please note that concrete trucks are required to have their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning, and to use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.



Traffic

Temporary traffic changes may be in place during the concrete pour as follows:

- The southbound curb lane on Main Street south of E. Broadway toward mid-block will be closed each day to stage concrete trucks.
- Concrete trucks will arrive and leave from the construction site via E. 10th Avenue, Quebec Street and the lane running between Quebec and E. 10th Avenue.
