





Concrete pours April 16 and 17 at future Broadway-City Hall Station

April 14, 2025

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation has scheduled concrete pours at the future Broadway-City Hall Station on April 16 and 17. Further details are below.



Construction Activities

Concrete pours will take place on April 16 and 17:

- April 16: Work hours are from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. The first concrete truck will arrive at around 9
- April 17: Work hours are from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. The first concrete truck will arrive at around 8 a.m.



What to expect

- April 16: A concrete pump truck will be set up at the west end of the construction site laydown area. Approximately five concrete trucks are expected.
- April 17: A concrete pump truck will be set up inside the construction site on Yukon Street south of W. Broadway. Approximately 10 concrete trucks are expected.
- Please note that concrete trucks are required to have their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning, and to use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.
- During large concrete pours, there may be times when additional holding areas for concrete trucks are temporarily required.



Traffic

Temporary traffic changes may be in place during the concrete pours as follows:

Concrete trucks will arrive to and leave from the construction site via Yukon Street between Broadway and W. 12th Avenue.
