



Concrete pours April 23 and 25 at future Broadway-City Hall Station

April 22, 2025

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation has scheduled concrete pours at the future Broadway-City Hall Station on April 23 and 25. Further details are below.



Construction Activities

Concrete pours will take place on April 23 and 25.

- Work hours differ for each pour, but will range from 7 a.m. until 4 p.m. The first concrete truck will arrive at 8 a.m.



What to expect

- A concrete pump truck will be set up both days at the west end of the construction site laydown area. Fewer than 10 concrete trucks are expected each day.
- Please note that concrete trucks are required to have their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning, and to use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.
- During large concrete pours, there may be times when additional holding areas for concrete trucks are temporarily required.



Traffic

Temporary traffic changes may be in place during the concrete pours as follows:

- Concrete trucks will arrive to and leave from the construction site via Yukon Street between Broadway and W. 12th Avenue.
