





South Granville: Utility Work Continues – Includes night activities

April 4, 2025

This work is highlighted in green on the map below and begins on April 7 at 7 a.m. Utility work will continue in the laneway east of Granville Street, between W. 10th Avenue and W. Broadway, as part of ongoing utility relocations for the future South Granville Station. This work is scheduled to continue until April 12 at 10 p.m. A map outlining the work area, specific stages, and anticipated road closures is provided below.



Construction Activities

From April 7 to April 12:

- Daytime work: 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Focus is on preparation and identification of the existing utilities, chipping, excavation, hydro-vac and backfilling.
- Night work: 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Work includes chipping as required, excavation and installation of the temporary utilities.



What to expect

- Intermittent construction noise is expected throughout the work period.
- This work is sequential, so some noisy activities will need to happen after 10 p.m. We will make every effort to minimize these occasions when possible.
- Increased trucks, equipment and workers in the laneway east of Granville Street.



Traffic

- Temporary traffic restrictions in the laneway are expected for the duration of this work and will be put into place on Sunday April 6, in advance of the work starting on April 7. Two eastbound lanes on W. Broadway between Granville and Hemlock streets will be closed. Eastbound traffic will be shifted into the westbound fast lane, maintaining one lane in each direction.
- There will be no access through the laneway to W. Broadway.
- A pedestrian detour will be in place on the south side of W. Broadway to maintain access between Granville and Hemlock streets.
