





# South Granville: Utility Work Update

### April 11, 2025

On Monday, April 14, utility work continues in the laneway east of Granville Street between W. 10th Ave and W. Broadway. This is the next phase of sequenced work to relocate utilities in the area, accommodating construction of the future South Granville Station. This stage of work will begin at 7 a.m., is expected to last approximately three weeks, and will require some overnight work along W. 10th Ave to be completed. A map of the work area, including the present stages, timing and expected traffic impacts, can be found below.



#### **Construction Activities**

Starting on April 14:

- Daytime work: 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Focus is on preparation of existing utilities, pavement cutting, excavation and backfilling.
- Intermittent night work: 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Focus is on excavation, installation of utilities, backfilling and road repair.
- This work is expected to continue for approximately three weeks.



#### What to expect

- Intermittent construction noise is expected throughout the work period.
- This work is sequential, so some noisy activities will need to happen after 10 p.m. We will make every effort to minimize these occasions when possible.
- Increased trucks, diesel pumps, equipment and workers in the laneway east of Granville Street and on W. 10th Ave.
- There will be no pedestrian access to W. Broadway through the laneway.



#### Traffic

- Temporary traffic restrictions in the laneway are expected for the duration of this work.
- Access to the laneway from Hemlock St. and W. 10th Ave will remain unobstructed.
- Intermittent lane restrictions on W. 10th Ave as required.

- Upcoming Work: Once the work highlighted in blue is complete, one or two nights of additional activity is anticipated along W. 10th Avenue (shown in purple) to complete this stage of utility work.
