

Upcoming concrete pours April 9 to 12 at Broadway-City Hall Station


The Broadway Subway Project Corporation has scheduled concrete pours at the future Broadway-City Hall Station from April 9 to 12. Further details are below.



Construction Activities

Concrete pours will take place from April 9 to 12

- Work hours are from 5 a.m. to 7 p.m. The first concrete truck will arrive at 7 a.m.
- Low-noise work will continue into the evening to complete related activities.



What to expect

- A concrete pump truck will be located inside the construction site laydown area during work.
- Approximately 3-12 concrete trucks are anticipated on April 9, 11 and 12, while 70 concrete trucks are anticipated on April 10.
- Please note that concrete trucks are required to have their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning, and to use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.
- During large concrete pours, there may be times when additional parking for concrete trucks is temporarily required. Your understanding is appreciated.



Traffic

Temporary traffic changes may be in place during the concrete pour as follows:

- Concrete trucks will arrive at and leave from the construction site via Yukon Street between Broadway and W. 12th Avenue.
