





Concrete pours May 7 and 8 at future Broadway-City Hall Station

May 5, 2025

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation has scheduled concrete pours at the future Broadway-City Hall Station on Wednesday, May 7 and Thursday, May 8. Further details are below.



Construction Activities

Concrete pours will take place on May 7 and 8.

- May 7: Work hours 7 a.m. − 1 p.m., with the first concrete truck arriving around 8 a.m.
 Approximately 5-6 concrete trucks are anticipated.
- May 8: Work hours 7 a.m. 7 p.m., with the first concrete truck arriving around 8 a.m.
 Approximately 35 concrete trucks are anticipated.



What to expect

- May 7: A concrete pump truck will be set up at the west end of the construction site laydown.
- May 8: A concrete pump truck will be set up on Yukon Street south of W. Broadway.
- Please note that concrete trucks are required to have their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning, and to use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.
- During large concrete pours, there may be times when additional holding areas for concrete trucks are temporarily required.



Traffic

Temporary traffic changes may be in place during the concrete pours as follows:

• Concrete trucks will arrive to and leave from the construction site via Yukon Street between Broadway and W. 12th Avenue.
