





Permanent utility work starts May 26 at the future Mount Pleasant Station

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation is in your neighbourhood building the future Mount Pleasant Station. On May 26, crews will begin setup for work on permanent utilities in the lane west of Main Street between E. Broadway and E. 8th Avenue. The work is expected to begin later this week and continue approximately seven weeks.



Construction Activities

Installation of two new manholes at the south end of the lane west of Main Street:

- Regular work hours are Monday to Saturday from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. There may be occasional work overnight, and on Sundays and holidays.
- When overnight work is required, work hours can range from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.



What to expect

- Intermittent elevated noise related to construction activities. Most of this utility work will happen during regular work hours, however, some limited overnight work may be required and notified of in advance.
- Increased trucks, construction equipment (including an excavator and hydrovac truck), and workers in the laneway.
- Pedestrian access on the north side of E. Broadway will be maintained throughout the work.
- When needed, overnight lighting focused on the permanent utility work to ensure crew safety.



Traffic

Temporary traffic changes will be in place during the permanent utility work:

- E. Broadway will be reduced to one lane in each direction between Main and Quebec streets.
- A portion of the lane west of Main Street will be closed from E. Broadway toward E. 8th Avenue.
- Please watch for and obey traffic control personnel and all signs, and plan extra travel time.



Mitigations

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to:

- White noise back-up signals on equipment when possible.
- Barriers around noisy work where possible.




