





South Granville Station Concrete Pour on June 26

June 25, 2025

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation has scheduled a concrete pour at South Granville Station on Thursday, June 26. Crews will complete a major structural concrete pour for the station.



Construction Activities

- Work begins at 6 a.m. with the first truck arriving at 7 a.m. The pour will be completed at approximately 6 p.m.
- Approximately 65 trucks are expected.



What to expect

- Two concrete pump trucks will be used during the pour with pumps positioned within the construction site.
- Low-noise work may continue into the evening to complete related activities.
- Please note that concrete trucks are required to keep their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning and will use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.
- During large concrete pours, temporary additional holding areas for concrete trucks may be required.



Traffic

Temporary traffic changes may be in place during the concrete pour as follows:

- Concrete trucks will arrive via W. 8th Avenue, and will leave via the lane running between W.
 8th Avenue and W. Broadway.
- Traffic control personnel will be on-site to manage pedestrians, cyclists and concrete trucks.
- Access to the businesses, health services, and residences will be maintained for all activities.
