Update on Great Northern Way-Emily Carr Station – Summer 2025

June 17, 2025

The above-ground station entrance at Great Northern Way-Emily Carr is taking shape. Crews completed the final concrete pour for the underground station's roof in May, fully enclosing the underground portion of the station. This summer, work will continue both above ground and within the underground station and tunnels, including installation of electrical and mechanical systems.

To complete this work efficiently, we will continue primarily working during the day, with occasional overnight work. We are committed to keeping residents and businesses informed as we advance this significant transit infrastructure project in your community.

What to expect during daytime work

- Regular work hours are from Monday to Friday from 6 a.m. until 10 p.m. There may be occasional work that starts earlier or work on Sunday and holidays.
- Some elevated noise during specific activities.
- Temporary traffic changes and pedestrian and cycling detours to accommodate construction activities.

What to expect at night

- When overnight work is required; work hours can range from 10 p.m. until 6 a.m.
- Overnight lighting focused on our sites to ensure safety.

We strive to minimize impacts of construction activities on our neighbours, and we are regularly monitoring and adapting mitigations as needed. See below for further information.

When travelling through construction zones, please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.

Construction Activities

- Pouring concrete.
- Delivering materials by trucks and cranes.
- Waterproofing and installing rebar.
- Commencing equipment installation in the station.
- Station construction is expected to continue through 2026.



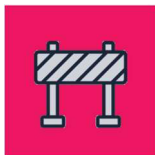
Traffic

Closures:

- Earl Finning Way between Fraser and Foley streets.
- Foley Street north of parking access lane.
- Fraser Street north of Great Northern Way is closed at E. 1st Avenue and Earl Finning Way.
- Temporary lane closures on Great Northern Way during concrete pours.

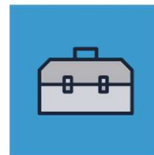
No parking:

- Along the north side of Great Northern Way, from 565 Great Northern Way west to Thornton Street.
- Occasional westbound lane closures on Great Northern Way



Impacts

- Some elevated noise related to activities that include, but are not limited to, rebar installation, crane movement, ventilation fans and deliveries.
- Concrete trucks are required to keep their engines running to keep their drums turning and use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.
- Trucking activity to accommodate deliveries of equipment and materials during the day or night.



Mitigations

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to:

- Noise barriers installed around some sources of noise.
- White noise back-up signals on equipment when possible.
- Directing site lights away from residential buildings.
- Using quieter models of equipment at night, such as hand tools.
- Access will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services.



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
