





# Oak-VGH Station Concrete Pour on August 9

### August 06, 2025

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation has scheduled a concrete pour at Oak-VGH Station on Saturday, August 09. Crews will complete a major structural concrete pour for the station roof.



#### **Construction Activities**

- Work begins at 5 a.m. with the first truck arriving at 6 a.m. The pour will be completed at approximately 10 p.m.
- Approximately 152 trucks are expected, that is approximately 5 trucks per hour at each of the three pump locations.



### What to expect

- Three pump trucks will be used for this pour, with two located on W. Broadway inside the station enclosure and one on Laurel Street within the construction area. Concrete trucks will access the site via eastbound W. Broadway or the laneway south of Broadway between Oak and Willow streets.
- Low-noise work may continue into the evening to complete related activities.
- Please note that concrete trucks are required to keep their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning and will use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.
- During large concrete pours, temporary additional holding areas for concrete trucks may be required.



#### **Traffic**

Temporary traffic changes may be in place during the concrete pour as follows:

- The southbound parking lane on Laurel Street will be closed to accommodate truck staging for the concrete pour.
- W. Broadway will be reduced to one lane in each direction between Spruce and Willow streets.
- Traffic control personnel will be on site to manage pedestrians, cyclists and concrete trucks.
- Access to the 950 W. Broadway parkade, businesses, health services, and residences will be maintained for all activities.
