





South Granville Station Concrete Pour on November 1

October 30, 2025

This weekend, crews will carry out the final roof concrete pour on Saturday, November 1, making South Granville the fourth station on the Broadway Subway Project to complete the underground roof. Approximately 1,250 m³ of concrete will be placed, enough to fill about 15 B-Line buses.



Construction Activities

- Work begins at 5 a.m. with the first truck arriving at 6 a.m. The pour will be completed at by approximately 6 p.m.
- Approximately 130 trucks are expected.



What to expect

- Three concrete pump trucks will be used during this pour as needed, with one pump positioned on W. Broadway and two within the construction enclosure.
- Low-noise work may continue into the evening to complete related activities.
- Please note that concrete trucks are required to keep their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning and will use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.
- During large concrete pours, temporary additional holding areas for concrete trucks may be required.



Traffic

Temporary traffic changes may be in place during the concrete pour as follows:

- W. Broadway will be reduced to one lane in each direction between Granville and Hemlock streets.
- Westbound left-turns closed (except buses) and eastbound right-turns restricted during work hours.
- Traffic control personnel will be on-site to manage pedestrians, cyclists and concrete trucks.
- Access to the businesses, health services, and residences will be maintained for all activities.
