





New phase of work begins at Broadway-City Hall Station

October 27, 2025

Backfilling is set to begin as early as October 28 at Broadway-City Hall Station, in the area between Alberta and Yukon streets. This is the second station on the Broadway Subway Project to reach this milestone. Backfilling is the process of filling the space between the station roof and the surface. This work will result in increased trucking activity, some traffic impacts, and intermittent noise as material is delivered to the excavation, positioned and compacted.



Construction Activities

Work hours for backfilling are Monday to Saturday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.



What to expect

- Backfilling operations will take place on W. Broadway between Alberta and Yukon streets, and on Yukon Street south of W. Broadway.
- The first phase of backfilling is expected to take approximately five to 10 weeks and is weather-dependent. Backfilling will continue after permanent utility work is complete.
- Intermittent elevated noise related to delivery, moving, and compacting of material, and related activities.
- Dust mitigation measures will be implemented throughout the work.
- Approximately 10,000 cubic metres of soils will be placed, enough to fill four Olympic-sized swimming pools.



Traffic

Current traffic conditions remain in place during the backfill as follows:

- Two lanes in each direction will be maintained on W. Broadway between Alberta and Yukon streets.
- There may be occasional temporary traffic stoppages on W. Broadway at Alberta to allow trucks to arrive to and leave from the backfilling location.
- The Room to Load zone on the south side of Broadway east of Alberta will be modified but maintained.
- Traffic control personnel will be deployed on Broadway between Alberta and Yukon Streets as required to manage vehicles, pedestrians, cyclists and trucks.
- Access to business, health services and residences will be maintained for all activities.
