





# Concrete pour October 22 at future Broadway-City Hall Station

### October 20, 2025

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation has scheduled a concrete pour at the future Broadway-City Hall Station on October 22. Further details are below.



#### **Construction Activities**

A concrete pour will take place on October 22:

- Work hours are from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. The first concrete truck will arrive at around 7 a.m.
- Low-noise work will continue into the evening to complete related activities.



#### What to expect

- Three concrete pump trucks will be set up at the west end of the construction site laydown area. Approximately 95 concrete trucks are expected.
- Please note that concrete trucks are required to have their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning, and to use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.
- During large concrete pours, there may be times when additional holding areas for concrete trucks are temporarily required.



#### **Traffic**

Temporary traffic changes may be in place during the concrete pours as follows:

• Concrete trucks will arrive to and leave from the construction site via Yukon Street between Broadway and W. 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
