





# South Granville: Utility Investigations Work in South Laneway

## October 16, 2025

Crews continue geotechnical investigation activities in the south laneway east of Granville Street, between W. 10th Avenue and W. Broadway. A map of the work area can be found below.



#### **Construction Activities**

Monday to Friday:

- Starting on October 20, this work is expected to continue for approximately two weeks.
- Daytime work: 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Focus is on location of the existing utilities, including excavation, hydro vac work and backfilling.



### What to expect

- Intermittent construction noise is expected through some work activities.
- Increased trucks, equipment and workers in the laneway east of Granville Street and south of W. Broadway.
- The sidewalk on W. Broadway remains open during the work.



#### Traffic

- Temporary traffic restrictions in the laneway are expected for the duration of this work.
- Watch for signs and obey traffic control personnel who are managing traffic in the laneways.
- Depending on the location of the work, access to the laneway may be from Hemlock Street or from 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
- Access to buildings and parkades adjacent to the laneway will be maintained.


