





South Granville Utility Work continues

October 10, 2025

UPDATE: The notice from October 2, 2025 mentioned this work and we have updated scheduling and activity to share.

The final stage of the temporary bypass work on Broadway and Hemlock Street continues through October. Once completed, permanent utility reinstatement for the future South Granville Station will begin. A map of the work area and expected traffic impacts can be found below.



Construction Activities

- Typical hours of work range from Monday to Friday: 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Activities focus on the excavation, saw cutting, hydrovac, backfilling and resurfacing work.
- Occasional overnight or weekend work may be required.



What to expect

- Elevated and intermittent noise related to construction activities.
- Increased trucks, equipment and workers in the laneway east of Granville Street.



Traffic

- Hemlock Street between W. Broadway and W. 10th Avenue will be one lane in each direction during the day. Nighttime traffic patterns may vary.
- Left turns on Hemlock Street and Broadway will be restricted.
- Use of the loading zones on Hemlock Street south of Broadway will be restricted.
- Intermittent closures of the laneway south of W. Broadway from Hemlock Street; access will remain available from W. 10th Avenue.
- Parking restrictions are in effect on Hemlock Street between W. Broadway and W. 11th Avenue.
- Traffic control personnel will be on site for assistance.




