





# South Granville Utility Work-Includes overnight activities

### October 02, 2025

Utility work at the future South Granville Station continues as the final stage of the temporary bypass work on Broadway and Hemlock Street begins on October 6. This work is required in preparation for the reinstatement of permanent utilities in the area. This work is expected to take at least a week and is weather dependent. A map of the work area, including the work areas and expected road closures, can be found below.

Following this phase, reinstatement of permanent utilities will begin. Further details, including schedule and impacts, will be provided in a separate notice.



#### **Construction Activities**

Monday to Friday: Weekend work may be required.

- Daytime work: 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. Activities focus on the installation of temporary bypass pipes, excavation, saw cutting, hydrovac, backfilling and resurfacing work.
- Intermittent overnight work: Activities focus on the installation of temporary bypass pipes.



#### What to expect

- Elevated and intermittent noise related to construction activities. We will aim to conduct the noisiest work before 10 p.m.
- Some activities will need to happen after 10 p.m. We will make every effort to minimize these occasions when possible.
- Increased trucks, equipment and workers in the laneway east of Granville Street.



#### Traffic

- Hemlock Street will be reduced to a single northbound lane between W. Broadway and W. 11th Avenue during the day. Nighttime traffic patterns may vary.
- Left-turns at Hemlock Street & Broadway intersection will be restricted; some right-turn restrictions will also be in place.
- The south laneway off Hemlock Street will be closed, access maintained via W. 10th Avenue.
- Loading zones on Hemlock Street south of Broadway will be restricted; a temporary loading area will be available.
- Parking restrictions will be in effect on both sides of Hemlock Street between Broadway and W. 11th Avenue.

- Pink area work zone along Hemlock Street south of W. Broadway
- Blue area work zone at the intersection of Hemlock Street and the south laneway
- Yellow area work zone extending toward W. 10th Avenue.
- Red area Restricted access to the laneway from Hemlock Street
- Work in these areas may occur sequentially or simultaneously, depending on site conditions, scheduling, and weather.
