





# Utility Investigation is Underway at the Broadway-City Hall Station

### October 24, 2025

Utility investigations on Yukon Street between 8th and 10th avenues will begin as early as October 28. This work is required in preparation for the reinstatement of permanent utilities in the area, which marks the next stage of construction for the Broadway-City Hall station.



#### **Construction Activities**

Starting as early as October 28:

- This work is sequential and is expected to continue for approximately two weeks.
- Regular Work Hours: 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Focus is on investigating the existing utilities, saw cutting, hydro vac, excavation and backfilling.



### What to expect

- Intermittent elevated construction noise related to hydro vac, excavation and saw cutting work.
- Increased trucks, construction equipment and workers in the area.



#### Traffic to be in place for some of the work

- Full closure of northbound Yukon Street between W. Broadway and north laneway.
- Eastbound left-turn and westbound right-turn restrictions at Yukon Street & W. Broadway intersection.
- No access from Yukon Street to the east-west laneway between Yukon St and Alberta Street.
- On Broadway, the current eastbound right-turn restriction at Yukon is maintained.

Work in these areas may occur sequentially or simultaneously, depending on site conditions, scheduling, and weather.

Following this phase, next phase of reinstatement of permanent utilities will begin. Further details, including schedule and impacts, will be provided in a separate notice.
