

## Utility investigations underway at the future Oak-VGH Station

October 10, 2025

Utility investigations along W. Broadway, Laurel and Oak streets will begin on October 14. This work is required in preparation for the reinstatement of permanent utilities in the area. A map of the work area and traffic impacts can be found below.



### Construction Activities

Starting on October 14:

- This work is sequential and is expected to continue for approximately two weeks.
- Regular Work Hours: 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Focus is on investigating the existing utilities, saw cutting, hydro vac, excavation and backfilling.
- Work activities will begin on Laurel Street and on the southeast corner of W. Broadway and Oak Street before progressing to other work locations as shown in the map below.



### What to expect

- Intermittent elevated construction noise related to hydro vac, excavation and saw cutting work.
- Increased trucks, construction equipment and workers in the area.



### Traffic

The following traffic conditions will be in place between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m.

- Oak Street will be reduced to one lane in each direction between W. Broadway and W. 10th Avenue.
- W. Broadway will be reduced to one lane in each direction between Spruce and Laurel streets.
- Left turns at the Oak Street and W. Broadway intersection will be restricted.
