

## Preparations for a one-block detour through E. 8th Avenue begin soon

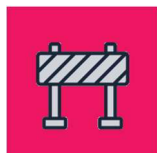

The Broadway Subway Project Team is in your neighbourhood getting ready for the upcoming bus detour planned for January 2026. You may notice crews working along Quebec Street, E. 8th Avenue, and Main Street. These preparations will create a temporary bus detour around the one-block closure of E. Broadway between Quebec and Main streets, helping to keep people and vehicles moving safely and efficiently during construction. The vehicle closure is key in allowing crews to remove the temporary traffic decks as quickly as possible, while minimizing night work.



### Construction Activities

- Typical work hours are Monday to Saturday, 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. Occasionally, work may take place overnight, start earlier, or occur on Sundays and holidays.
- Preparatory activities for the bus detour which will include geotechnical work, saw cutting, intermittent hydrovac work, landscaping, modifying sidewalks, road work, and installing temporary traffic lights at Main and E. 8th Avenue.



### What to expect

- Some elevated noise related to activities that include, but are not limited to, concrete chipping, saw cutting, and hydrovac excavation.
- Trucking activity to accommodate deliveries of equipment and materials during the day.
- Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services.



### Traffic

Temporary traffic changes may be in place as follows:

### Mitigations

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to:

- Noise barriers installed around some sources of noise.
- White noise back-up signals on equipment when possible.
- Directing lights away from residential buildings.
- Using quieter models of equipment at night, such as hand tools.
- Wayfinding signage for local businesses.
