





The first level of backfilling set to begin at Mount Pleasant Station

November 7, 2025

Backfilling is set to begin as early as November 12 at Mount Pleasant Station from the southside of E. Broadway between Main and Quebec streets. This is the third station on the Broadway Subway Project to start this work. Backfilling is the process of filling the space between the station roof and the surface. The first level of backfilling will act as a layer of protection over the station roof as new equipment and materials begin to arrive to facilitate the removal of the traffic deck in the new year. Work will continue through December and is weather-dependent.



Construction Activities

- Work hours for backfilling are Monday to Saturday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- Delivery, moving, and compacting of material; trucking; and some welding or carpentry work if needed.



What to expect

- Backfilling operations are in the station laydown area between E. Broadway and E. 10th Avenue.
- Intermittent elevated noise related to construction activities.
- Dust mitigation measures will be implemented throughout the work.



Traffic

Traffic conditions in place during the backfill are as follows:

- Trucks will utilize Main Street for trucking activities.
- Trucks to use Main Street, E. 10th Avenue and the north-south laneway to enter the laydown.
- Trucks will back-in from E. 10th Avenue using the north-south laneway via the ramp inside the laydown.
- Flaggers will be on site to assist pedestrians, cyclists and vehicles.
