

Broadway-City Hall night work on November 18

November 14, 2025

The Broadway Subway Project will be temporarily moving a mobile crane to the intersection of Cambie Street and W. Broadway on Tuesday, November 18. Crews will then lift construction equipment into the project site on the west side of Cambie Street.



Construction Activities

- Work hours are between 10 p.m. and continuing until 4 a.m. the following morning.
- Activities include: moving a mobile crane to the west side of the intersection to lift equipment into the site on Cambie Street.



What to expect

- Some elevated noise related to crane movement of equipment into the excavation.
- Lighting focused on work area to ensure crew safety.
- Increased trucking, temporary lane closures and changes to pedestrian access to accommodate delivery and lowering of equipment into the excavation area.



Traffic

Temporary lane closures for this work are:

- W. Broadway will be reduced to one lane in each direction.
- Left turns from W. Broadway onto Cambie Street will be restricted.
- Cambie Street southbound will be reduced to one lane.
- The west crosswalk across W. Broadway will be closed.
- There will be intermittent stoppages on the south crosswalk across Cambie Street when there is overhead work.
