





Night work on Cambie Street at Broadway-City Hall Station on November 12

November 7, 2025

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation will be working at night on Wednesday, November 12 to relocate concrete barriers and move construction fencing on the east side of Cambie Street next to entrance to the Canada Line at Broadway-City Hall Station. The work supports removal of the temporary pedestrian path around construction, and reinstatement of the sidewalk and bus stop.



Construction Activities

- Work hours: 8 p.m. Wednesday, November 12 to 6 a.m. Thursday, November 13.
- Concrete barriers and construction fence panels will be moved closer to the Canada Line Station, and temporary ramps that served as sidewalk letdowns will be removed.



What to expect

- Some elevated noise related to activities including, but not limited, to crane operation.
- The north-south sidewalk on the east side of Cambie between W. 10th Avenue and Broadway will be closed during the work. Pedestrians will be directed to use the west sidewalk.
- Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services.



Traffic

Temporary traffic changes may be in place as follows:

Cambie will be reduced to one lane northbound during this work.



Mitigations

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to:

- White noise back-up signals on equipment when possible.
- Directing lights away from residential buildings.
- Using quieter models of equipment at night, such as hand tools.
