





Backfilling Phase 2 begins at Arbutus Station

December 3, 2025

This December, the Broadway Subway Project crew at Arbutus Station begins the second phase of backfilling along Broadway, between Maple and Cypress streets. Backfilling is the process of filling the space between the station roof and the surface with soil. This work will result in increased trucking activity, some traffic impacts, and intermittent noise as material is delivered into the excavation, moved into place and then compacted.



Construction Activities

- Work hours are Monday to Saturday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- Activities are expected to continue through January and are weather dependent.



What to expect

- Intermittent elevated noise related to delivery, moving, and compacting of material and related activities.
- Dust mitigation measures will be implemented throughout the work.



Traffic

- Current traffic conditions remain in place.
- There will be occasional temporary traffic stoppages on Broadway to allow truck turns.
- Traffic control personnel will be deployed on W. Broadway, between Cypress and Arbutus streets as required to manage construction truck movements.
- Access to businesses, health services, and residences will be maintained.
