

Night work on Cambie Street between December 16-18

December 15, 2025

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation will be working for three nights starting Tuesday, December 16 to lengthen the bus bay on the east side of Cambie Street next to the Broadway-City Hall Canada Line station entrance.



Construction Activities

- Work hours: 7 p.m. to 4 a.m. for three nights starting Tuesday, December 16.
- Removing the concrete sidewalk and curbs, excavating, and compacting soil and asphalt to expand the northbound bus stop to accommodate two buses.



What to expect

- Elevated noise related to some construction activities.
- The north-south sidewalk on the east side of Cambie Street between W. 10th Avenue and Broadway will be closed. Pedestrians will be directed to use the west sidewalk.
- Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services.



Traffic

Temporary traffic conditions will be in place as follows:

- Cambie Street will be reduced to one lane northbound during this work; two southbound lanes will be maintained.



Mitigations

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to:

- White noise back-up signals on equipment when possible.
- Directing lights away from residential buildings.
- Using quieter models of equipment at night, such as hand tools.
