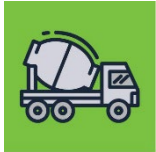


## Night work at Broadway-City Hall on January 9

January 8, 2026

The Broadway Subway Project will be working in the intersection of Cambie Street and W. Broadway on Friday, January 9 through to the early morning on January 10.



### Construction Activities

- Work hours are between 10 p.m. on January 9 and continuing until 4 a.m. the following morning.
- Activities include: moving a mobile crane to the west side of the intersection to lift equipment from the site on to Cambie Street.



### What to expect

- Some elevated noise related to construction activities, including but not limited to crane movement of equipment out of the excavation and onto Cambie Street.
- Lighting focused on work area to ensure crew safety.
- Increased trucking, temporary lane closures and changes to pedestrian access to accommodate delivery and lowering of equipment into the excavation area.



### Traffic

Temporary lane closures for this work are:

- W. Broadway will be reduced to one lane in each direction between Ash and Yukon streets.
- Cambie Street southbound will be reduced to one lane between W. 8th Avenue and W. Broadway.
- The west crosswalk across W. Broadway at Cambie Street will be closed.
- There will be intermittent restrictions on the south crosswalk across Cambie Street when there is overhead work.
