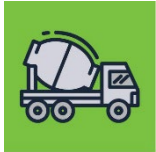


Overnight work in advance of one-block Broadway closure

January 22, 2026

The Broadway Subway Project will be completing overnight work to prepare for the one-block Broadway closure on E. 8th Avenue between Quebec and Main streets from January 25 until January 26 at 7 a.m.



Construction Activities

- Overnight activities to prepare for the vehicle detour include: street cleaning, line painting, landscaping, road maintenance, electrical work, delivery and installation of safety medians, signage installation, and relocation of bus stops.



What to expect

- Intermittent and elevated noise related to some construction activities.
- Parking on E. 8th Avenue will be removed between Quebec and Main streets to accommodate buses and local traffic.

Traffic

Traffic conditions will be in place during the road works as follows:

- There will be lane changes on E. 8th Avenue between Quebec and Main streets. Please obey all traffic signage and personnel.
- Members of the Vancouver Police Department will be assisting traffic at key intersections during the preparatory works and will remain for the initial weeks of the closure.
