



Utility investigations begin at the future Mount Pleasant station


February 24, 2026

Utility investigations on Main Street at Broadway will begin as early as February 25. This work is required in preparation for the reinstatement of permanent utilities in the area and marks the next stage of construction for the future Mount Pleasant station.



Construction Activities

- Regular work hours are from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m.
- Work activities include but are not limited to: investigating the existing utilities, saw cutting, hydrovac excavation, road work and backfilling.



What to expect

- Intermittent elevated construction noise.
- Increased trucks, construction equipment and workers in the area.



Traffic

- Temporary changes to the west pedestrian crosswalk on Main Street at Broadway may be required depending on the utility investigations.
- There may be additional traffic impacts depending on the results of the preliminary investigations.
- Please watch for and obey traffic control personnel and all signs and plan extra travel time.
