



Night work to relocate water main in Mount Pleasant begins March 30

March 27, 2026

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation is in your neighbourhood restoring E. Broadway between Main and Quebec streets. As part of this work, crews will be working at night March 30 through the morning of April 3 to connect the new water main to the city's water system and install new water service connections to individual buildings. Water to neighbouring businesses and residences will be temporarily shut off between midnight and 6 a.m. on select nights. The work will be performed overnight to minimize the impact on businesses and residents.



Construction Activities

Water main tie-in and water service connections:

- Work hours are from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., starting March 30 at 10 p.m. through April 3 at 6 a.m.



What to expect

- Residents and businesses may experience elevated noise including but not limited to: saw cutting of utility pipes.
- Overnight lighting focused on our work area to ensure crew safety.
- Water will be shut off to select buildings on select nights between midnight and 6 a.m.
- Project staff are directly sharing further information with the businesses and residents that will be affected by the water shutdown.
