



South Granville: Night Work on Hemlock Street for permanent utility starts in early March

March 5, 2026

Permanent utility work at the future South Granville Station is ongoing. Crews will be completing utility reinstatement work at the intersection of W. Broadway and Hemlock Street during the night to minimize daytime traffic disruptions. Night work is expected to occur for approximately two weeks and is weather dependent. Construction Activities

- Night work hours: 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., for approximately two weeks, starting as early as March 9, 2026.
- Activities include: hydrovac as required, concrete chipping, excavation and installation of the permanent utilities, backfilling and resurfacing work.



What to expect

- Intermittent construction noise is expected throughout the work period.
- While we strive to complete noisy work by 10 p.m., this work is sequential, so some noisy activities will need to happen after 10 p.m.
- Increased trucks, equipment and workers at the Hemlock Street and Broadway intersection.

Traffic

- Hemlock Street will continue to be a single northbound lane only between W. Broadway and W. 8th Avenue.
- Single-lane alternating traffic on W. Broadway at the Hemlock Street intersection between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- Left turns at the Hemlock Street and Broadway intersection will be restricted; some right-turn restrictions will also be in place.
- Parking restrictions will be in effect on Hemlock Street between W. 8th and W.10th Avenues.
- Pedestrians will be detoured around the work area as needed.
- Access to businesses, health services, and residences will be maintained.



Mitigations

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to:

- Directing lights away from residential buildings.
- Traffic control personnel will be on site to help manage pedestrians and vehicles.
- Noise barriers installed around some sources of noise.
