

Micropiling activities on W. Broadway east of Cambie, includes night work

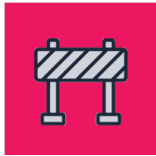
April 17, 2026

Construction of a station ventilation shaft is continuing on the north side of W. Broadway between Cambie and Yukon streets. Mobilization of crews and equipment will begin the week of April 20, with crews drilling and installing micropiles starting April 27.



Construction Activities

- Work hours: Monday – Saturday, 24 hours a day for approximately one month.
- Work activities include, but are not limited to: installing traffic controls, excavating by hydrovac to expose underground utilities, cutting and removing a portion of traffic deck panels, micropiling and reinstating the road.



What to expect

- Increased construction equipment and workers in the area.
- Intermittent periods of increased noise during the micropiling.
- Safety fencing around the work zone.
- Overnight lighting focused on our work site to ensure crew safety.
- Access to businesses, health services, and residences will be maintained.



Traffic

- W. Broadway will be reduced to one lane in each direction between Cambie and Yukon streets.



Mitigations

- Noise barriers installed around some sources of noise, where possible.
- Directing lights away from residential buildings.
