



Night work to install steel structure for Mount Pleasant entrance May 25 through early June

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood constructing the entrance to the future Mount Pleasant Station. As part of this work, crews will be working day and night May 25 through early June to install the steel structure for the above-ground station entrance.



Construction Activities

- Daytime work hours are Monday to Sunday, from 6 a.m. until 10 p.m. Daytime activities include crane operations, cutting and grinding steel, installing bolts, and welding
- Overnight work hours continue until 3 a.m. Nighttime activities include welding.



What to expect

- Residents and businesses may experience elevated noise during some activities.
- Noisier work to be completed during daytime hours.
- Overnight lighting focused on our work area to ensure crew safety.
