



Night work on Cambie Street and Broadway on June 11-13

June 11, 2026

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood restoring the west side of Cambie Street south of W. Broadway after constructing underground passenger connections between the Canada Line platform and the new Millennium Line platform at Broadway-City Hall Station. As part of this work, crews will be working overnight June 11/12 and June 12/13 to remove the final sections of the pedestrian walkway and finish backfilling the area. The work is being performed at night to minimize business disruptions.



Construction Activities

- Regular work hours are from 7 a.m. – 10 p.m.
- Night work hours are from 10 p.m. – 7 a.m.



What to expect

- Some elevated noise, including but not limited to, crane operations, backfilling and compacting backfill material.
- Noisier work to be completed during daytime hours.
- Overnight lighting focused on our work area to ensure crew safety.
