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Traffic Alert: Temporary two-block road closure at Broadway-City Hall Station begins July 20

July 17, 2026

Starting on Monday July 20, 2026, W. Broadway will be closed to vehicles between Alberta and Cambie streets while crews remove the traffic deck and restore the roadway. The two-block detour will begin at approximately 9 a.m. and be in place for approximately six months. Please watch for and obey traffic control personnel and all signs, and plan extra travel time.

Neighbourhood Destination Traffic:

- Sidewalks remain open and businesses, health services and residences will continue to have multiple access and exit points.
- Westbound traffic can access the neighbourhood using Alberta Street.
- Eastbound traffic can access the neighbourhood using Ash Street. Eastbound through traffic on 8th Avenue will not be permitted to cross Cambie Street. Drivers can use 7th Avenue.
- Street parking along the detour route will be removed. Parkades and other parking options remain available in the area.

Commuter Through Traffic:

- Drivers commuting through the neighbourhood are encouraged to use alternate major routes.
- Westbound traffic on Broadway will be detoured via Alberta Street, 8th Avenue and Ash Street.
- Eastbound traffic on Broadway can turn left on Ash Street, and right on 7th Avenue, or turn right on Cambie.
- Eastbound traffic on Broadway will not be permitted to turn left to northbound Cambie.

Transit:

- Access to the Canada Line at Broadway-City Hall Station remains open.
- Buses will detour to 8th Avenue using Alberta and Cambie streets.
- No bus stops will be relocated to the transit detour route.
