

Paving and line painting in Mount Pleasant; includes night work

August 19, 2026

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood reinstating E. Broadway near the future Mount Pleasant Station. Between August 20 and 23, BSPC will be milling the road surface, paving, and painting traffic lines on E. Broadway from the intersection at Main Street to west of Quebec Street. Crews will be performing the noisier works of milling and paving during the day on August 20 and 21, respectively, while line painting will take place overnight August 22 into the morning of August 23.



Construction Activities

- Activities include, but are not limited to:
 - August 20, 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.: road surface milling and trucking;
 - August 21, 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.: trucking, paving and asphalt compaction; and
 - August 22-23, 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.: line painting.



What to expect

- Elevated noise related to some construction activities.
- Sidewalks remain open and accessible; however, pedestrians may be re-routed around work zones.
- Access will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services.



Traffic

Temporary traffic conditions will be in place as follows:

- E. Broadway will be reduced to one lane in each direction from the intersection of E. Broadway at Main Street to mid-block west of Quebec Street.
- Main Street will be reduced to one lane southbound between E. 7th and E. 10th avenues.
