

South Granville Station – Night Work on August 17

August 14, 2026

Note: The notice from August 7, 2026 has been rescheduled and we have additional details to share.

Crews are continuing construction of the future South Granville Station, as work progresses inside and outside the station. Night work to complete utility installations has been rescheduled to August 17.

The utility tie-in is scheduled overnight when sanitary sewer flows are significantly lower. This approach minimizes impacts to daytime sanitary sewer use while helping to ensure the health and safety of crews performing the work.



Construction Activities

- On August 17, utility work will take place at W. 10th Avenue and laneway entrance between Granville and Hemlock streets from 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
- Activities may include but are not limited to increased concrete chipping, truck traffic, hydrovac, and workers on W. 10th Avenue.
- Regular work hours continue from Monday to Saturday from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m.



What to expect

- Overnight lighting and equipment will be in the enclosed utility work area.
- A dewatering pump will remain in place throughout the work, and a hydrovac will be used as required to support safe working conditions for crews.



Mitigations

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to:

- Noise barriers installed around hydrovac when in use.
