

Traffic Alert: Traffic pattern change on W. Broadway between Spruce and Willow Streets

August 27, 2026

- On Friday, August 28, traffic will be shifted from the traffic deck on the north side of W. Broadway to the south side of the street between Oak and Laurel streets.
- To complete this change, Vancouver Police officers may be directing traffic at the intersection of W. Broadway and Oak Street and at W. Broadway and Laurel Street beginning Thursday, August 27 until Friday, August 28 at 5 p.m.
- Beginning Thursday, August 27, left turns from W. Broadway onto Oak Street will be restricted. Once the work is complete on August 28, right turns from W. Broadway westbound onto Oak Street northbound will be reinstated.
- This traffic change will allow crews to complete removal of the traffic deck and restore the road and sidewalk at the future Oak-VGH Station.
- Access to businesses, health services, and residences will be maintained.
- Please watch for and obey traffic control personnel and all signs, and plan extra travel time.
