

Permanent utility installation on Main Street at Broadway

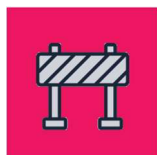

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood reinstating utilities near the future Mount Pleasant Station. Between September 14 and 22, BSPC will be connecting storm and sanitary sewer utilities on Main Street south of E. Broadway.



Construction Activities

- Work hours: 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. daily, including Saturday and Sunday.
- Activities include, but are not limited to:
 - Saw cutting and removing asphalt and concrete;
 - Excavating using a hydrovac truck;
 - Pipe cutting and installation; and
 - Reinstating the road by backfilling and paving.



What to expect

- Elevated noise related to some construction activities.
- The east-west crosswalk on the south side of Main Street at E. Broadway will be closed 24/7.
- The sidewalk on the west side of Main Street south of E. Broadway will be closed intermittently. Access to businesses will be maintained from E. 10th Avenue throughout this work.
- Access will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services.



Temporary traffic conditions

- Main Street will be reduced to one lane in each direction between Kingsway and E. 10th Avenue 24/7. Lanes may shift on Main Street depending on work locations.
- The southbound #3 bus stop #50238 will be relocated to the south side of E. 10th Avenue.
- Parking will be restricted on Main Street from E. Broadway north towards the mid-block.
- The loading zone on the west side of Main Street between E. 8th Avenue and E. Broadway will be closed.

 - White noise back-up signals on equipment when possible.
